About Solidaritech:

Solidaritech is a Community Interest Company that helps Refugees and Asylum Seekers get access to technology. We work with businesses and individuals to help them donate tech – whether it be laptops, desktops, tablets or smartphones. We then wipe the machines, repair any problems and allocate these out to migrants to enable them to pursue their studies, start businesses or convert their existing qualifications to UK standards.

Over the last year we've helped work with partners to ensure that over a thousand refurbished devices have gone to digitally excluded people in Yorkshire and Humber fleeing conflicts in places like Ukraine, Afghanistan, Iran and Sudan. We've helped kids do their homework and adults to find jobs and start businesses. We've managed to do all of this with donated and refurbished devices, and **we need your help to do more.**

At Solidaritech we professionally repair, then re-home, laptops, phones, PCs and tablets. We also guarantee that all unusable devices and parts are 100% recycled by a reputable, IT recycling specialist, [Ucan Recycling](#).

So look in your cupboard, loft or basement and please donate your unloved tech. We've made it as simple as possible to drop off your tech, or set up a group Collection Hub. And, for your peace of mind, we guarantee that all devices are treated anonymously and all data is professionally erased, and our corporate clients even receive a Certificate of Data Destruction.

We've called it our Christmas Appeal but we'd love to receive the tech you have replaced over the last few years, or even in the last few weeks. If you replaced devices with a Black Friday bargain, a present or something from the January Sales, please donate your old tech rather than leave it on the shelf.

The Appeal will run to 31st January 2023 – so the technology you replace at Christmas or in the January Sales will also help our donation drive. When you donate, your tech will help us offer hope to refugees in the UK and digitally empower them so they can connect to our society.

One last thing, Solidaritech is more about people than technology. We answer the phone when you call and we are here to ensure your donation, or the setting up of your own Collection Hub, goes as smoothly as possible. So whether you want to just drop us your old laptop, or you want your work to donate your old office computers the next time you get new ones, there's a way we can do it.

No tech but still want to help?

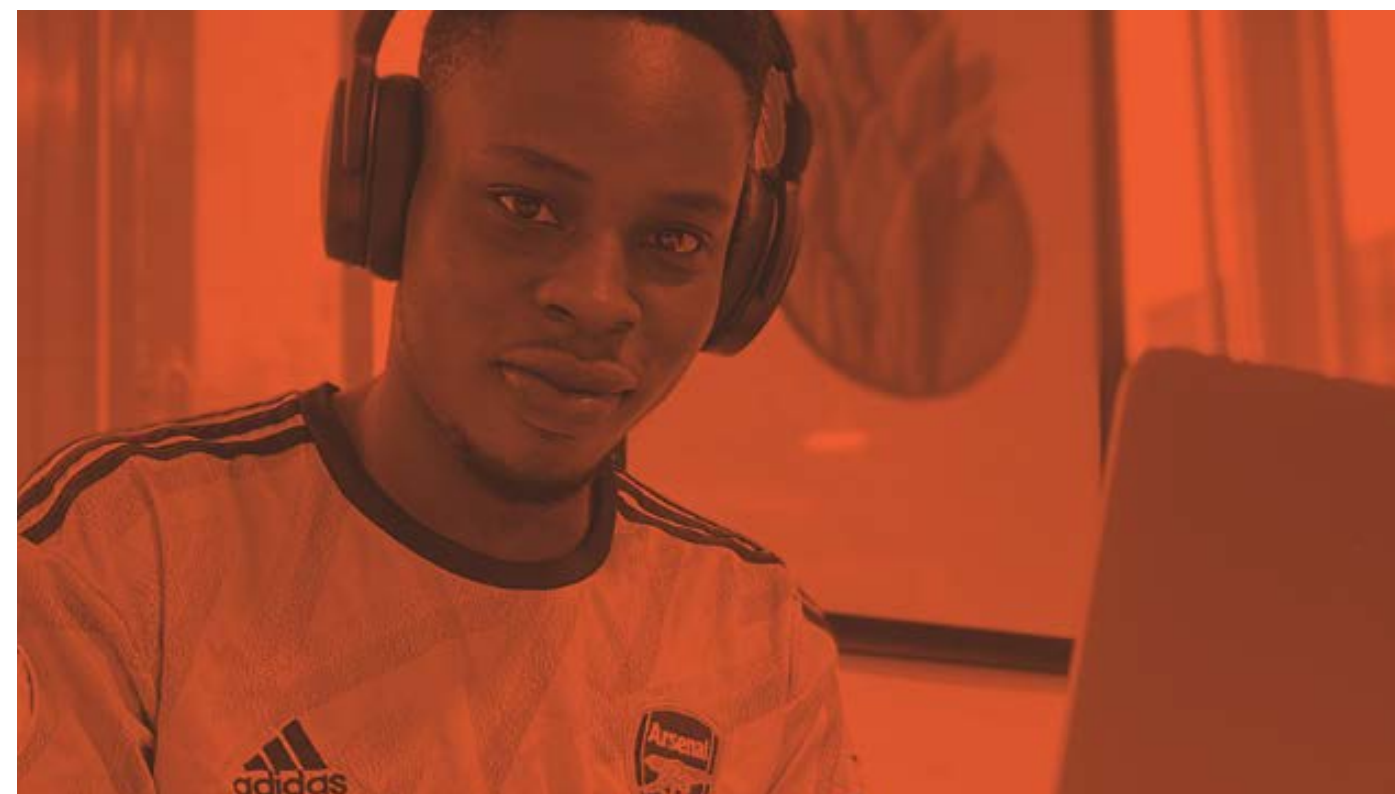
