Solidaritech professionally wipe the device's drives, installing new Operating Systems to make a new, quicker and more usable machine.

Solidaritech was formed in 2017, and since then we've provided over 5,000 devices to people referred to us either directly or via partner organisations in the migrant support sector. We have deep and strong links in our local community and further afield across the Yorkshire and Humber region.

We started off as a small community project, but have since grown in size to deliver European funded projects and have attracted funding from organisations such as The National Lottery, Power to Change, Postcode Lottery and Allen Lane Foundation.

We aren't all 'techies', we believe that access to technology is a crucial part of participating in UK life in the twenty-first century.

About The Role

The Assistant IT Technician at Solidaritech CIC will play a crucial role in processing donated technology (PCs, laptops, phones, tablets) to support refugees and asylum seekers. This role offers the opportunity to learn and grow while contributing to Solidaritech's mission. The technician will work closely with the lead technician, customer support coordinator, and CEO on various tasks, ensuring that donated devices are recycled, repaired, and distributed efficiently.


The ideal candidate will be confident in communication, able to interact effectively with clients, volunteers, and staff. They should possess strong organisational skills, as they will be responsible for logging and recording the processing of hardware, time, sickness, and expenditure. The assistant will also assist with general administrative duties such as answering calls, emails, and welcoming visitors.

A key part of the role involves adhering to data protection and data destruction regulations when handling donated devices. The technician will also contribute to innovation by suggesting efficient ways to use hardware and software in the recycling process. Safety is critical, and the assistant will need to follow health and safety protocols while working with electrical equipment and chemicals.

The role requires a motivated individual with a strong desire to learn and develop their technical skills. They should be familiar with refurbished laptops, phones, tablets, and PCs, and be comfortable troubleshooting and responding to technical queries from clients. The technician will also work collaboratively within a small team, ensuring that all work aligns with Solidaritech's values of inclusion, equality, and anti-oppression.

In summary, the ideal candidate will be confident, communicative, organised, and technically skilled in refurbished technology. They should be committed to Solidaritech's mission and be flexible in working hours, including evenings and weekends when required.

How Solidaritech's SolidCRM Works

The development of SolidCRM has been the culmination of a lot of work by staff and volunteers, and since being launched last year it has seen an impact on both donations in and donations out. However, SolidCRM is not a completed piece of technology, it is instead an evolving piece of work which we are continuing to augment around staff, donors and volunteers to ensure it gives us what we want as a business.

SolidCRM allows us to capture referral data through forms on the front end of the website, this feeds into our referrals process, with the person being referred or the referring agency then being contacted to establish their needs before a matching machine is either dispatched or made available to be picked up.

However, this process is the bare minimum of what can be achieved and there are several points within it that we can expand on to do a better job. These could be, but aren't limited to, having a longer dialogue during the matching process with the client referred to us, returning to clients after they've received technology to see how the process was for them and integrating any process changes based on client feedback into the SolidCRM and client process.

We may also benefit from more regular contact with larger-scale corporate donors, to ensure that the supply of technology better meets the demand, which has historically always outstripped supply. SolidCRM can help diarise these calls, by logging interactions.
